#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Grant permission to the Development Services Department to administratively accept the Required Off-Site Improvement Facilities (roads, drainage, water and wastewater) for Maintenance to serve Suncoast Community Health Center Ruskin Off-Site, located in Section 09, Township 32, and Range 19, upon proper completion, submittal and approval of all required documentation. Also provide the administrative rights to release the warranty security upon expiration of the warranty period, warranty inspection and correction of any failure, deterioration or damage to the Improvement Facilities. Accept a Warranty Check in the amount of \$17,200.30 and authorize the Chairman to execute the Developer's Agreement for Warranty of Required Improvements.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On January 29, 2024, Permission to Construct was issued for Suncoast Community Health Center Ruskin Off-Site, after construction plan review was completed on November 29, 2023. The developer has submitted the required Check, which the County Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved. The developer is Suncoast Community Health Centers, Inc and the engineer is 5M Civil, LLC.

## OWNER/DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT FOR WARRANTY OF REQUIRED OFF-SITE IMPROVEMENTS

#### Witnesseth

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County has adopted site development regulations which are set forth in the Land Development Code (hereafter the "Site Development Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, Site Development the Regulations authorize the County accept ownership and/or maintenance responsibility off-site improvement facilities constructed the Owner/Developer conjunction with site development in Hillsborough County, projects provided improvement facilities that the meet County standards and are warranted against defects in workmanship and materials for a period of two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Developer has completed certain off-site improvement facilities in conjunction with the site development project known as Suncoast Community Health Center Ruskin (hereafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Site Development Regulations, the Owner/Developer has requested the County to accept the aforementioned off-site improvement facilities for ownership and/or maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Developer has represented the County that the completed improvement facilities have been constructed in accordance with the approved plans and applicable County regulations and technical specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Developer has offered to warranty the off-site improvement facilities against any defects in workmanship and materials and to correct any such defects which arise during the warranty period.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the intent and desire of the Owner/Developer as set forth herein, and to gain acceptance for ownership and/or maintenance by the County of the aforementioned off-site improvement facilities, the Owner/Developer and the County agree as follows:

- 1. The terms, conditions and regulations contained in the Site Development Regulations are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this Agreement.
- 2. of two (2) years following the date of acceptance the off-site improvement facilities for ownership and/or maintenance by the County, the Owner/Developer agrees to warrant the off-site improvement facilities described below against failure. deterioration or damage resulting from defects in materials. The Owner/Developer agrees to correct within the warranty period any such

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failure, deterioration or damage existing in the improvement facilities so that said improvement facilities thereafter comply with the technical specifications contained in the approved plans and Site Development Regulations. The off-site improvement facilities to be warranted constructed in conjunction with the Project are as follows:

209 LF of 6" DIP water main, 63 LF of 4" PVC force main, roadway and drainage improvements on 15th Street SE

A copy of said letter of credit, warranty bond, or cashier/certified check is attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

- 4. In the event the Owner/Developer shall fail or neglect to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement and as required by the Site Development Regulations, the Owner/Developer shall be liable to pay for the cost of reconstruction of defective off-site improvement facilities to the final total cost, including but not limited to engineering, legal and contingent costs, together with any damages, either direct or consequential, which the County may sustain as a result of the Owner/Developer's failure or neglect to perform.
- 5. The County agrees, pursuant to the terms contained in the Site Development Regulations, to accept the off-site improvement facilities for maintenance, at such time as:
  - a) The Engineer-of-Record for the Owner/Developer certifies in writing that said off-site improvement facilities have been constructed in accordance with:
    - (1) The plans, drawings, and specifications submitted to and approved by the County's Development Review Division of Development Services Department; and
    - (2) All applicable County regulations relating to the construction of the offsite improvement facilities; and
  - Authorized representatives of the County's Development Review Division of Development Services Department have reviewed the Engineer-of-Record's

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certification and have not found any discrepancies existing between the constructed improvement facilities and said certification.

- 6. If any part of this Agreement is found invalid and unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the other parts of this Agreement if the rights and obligations of the parties contained herein are not materially prejudiced and the intentions of the parties can be effectuated.
- 7. This document, including all exhibits and other documents incorporated herein by reference, contains the entire agreement of the parties. It shall not be modified or altered except in writing signed by the parties.

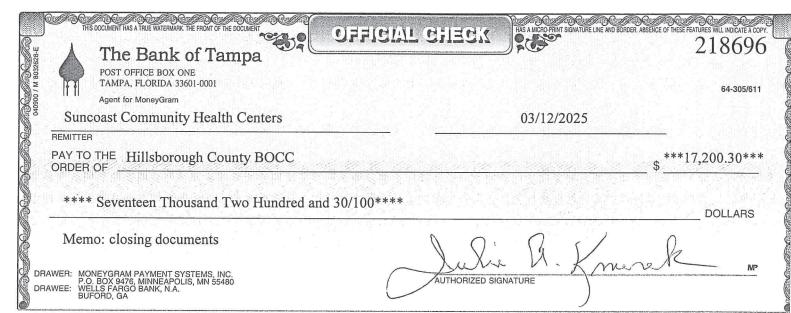

Subtotal Warranty Amount = (\$68,307.00) x .10 = \$6,830.70

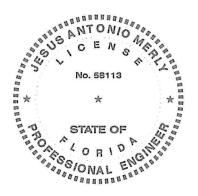
