<p>Background: In 2023, the Florida Legislature created the Live Local Act, which provides for administrative approval of multi-family housing developments in certain zoning districts without approval by the Board of County Commissioners. The state legislation has generated a great deal of public discussion. The Board of County Commissioners would benefit from basic information from staff about these projects as they begin and move forward through the administrative process.</p>
