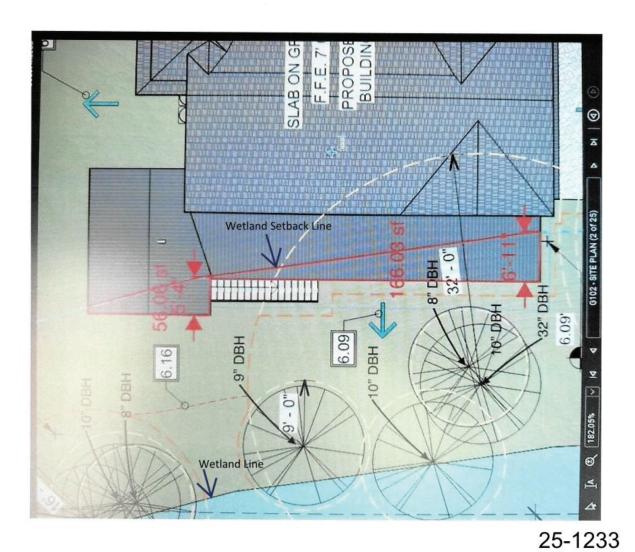

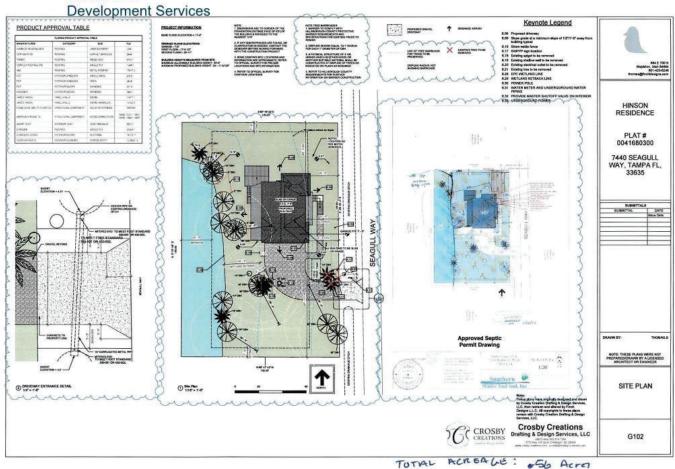

The impact to the actual terra firma is de minimis, in the form of simple support columns, however the overhand, though "in air" only, does encroach into the "vertical" element of the setback. It should be noted that the applicant has disagreed with the relevant jurisdictions as to whether or not the water body triggering the setback is in fact natural or jurisdictional. 2. Variance Criteria Response

1. Explain how the alleged hardships or practical difficulties are unique and singular to the subject property and are not those suffered in common with other property similarly located?

The subject property is part of an area with no structured development pattern in a coastal area just off of Tampa Bay. The water body triggering the request is actually freshwater and appears to be an artificial waterbody; however, the relevant agency(s) have asserted jurisdiction.

Describe how the literal requirements of the Land Development Code (LDC) would deprive you of rights commonly enjoyed by other properties in the same district and area under the terms of the LDC.

the request is to allow for the overhang of a semi-cantilevered porch on the 2nd story. the literal requirements of the LDC in thsi instance are to protect sensitive waterbodies, and this second story porch area creates no potential threat to such or compromises any intent to protect environmentally sensitive areas.

3. Explain how the variance, if allowed, will not substantially interfere with or injure the rights of others whose property would be affected by allowance of the variance.

There are no adjoining or peripheral properties would be at all affected by the second story porch

Further the porch presents no line of site or other privacy issues for surrounding properties

4. Explain how the variance is in harmony with and serves the general intent and purpose of the LDC and the Comprehensive Plan (refer to Section 1.02.02 and 1.02.03 of the LDC for description of intent/purpose).

The comprehenisve plan seeks to further harmony and compatibility with existing development and our natural features, and allowing a second story porch with a minimal vertical intrusion into the setback is entirely harmonious with the coastal character of the community and also, again, does not present and compatibility or consistency concerns.

5. Explain how the situation sought to be relieved by the variance does not result from an illegal act or result from the actions of the applicant, resulting in a self-imposed hardship.

The applicant is "asking permission" ahead of construction or any activities which would otherwise require this variance.

6. Explain how allowing the variance will result in substantial justice being done, considering both the public benefits intended to be secured by the LDC and the individual hardships that will be suffered by a failure to grant a variance.

Substantial justice will have been achieved if the applicant is allowed to construct the porch in question; the porch has almost zero tangible impact on the surrounding environment and is entirely in line, again, with the coastal character of the community.
